Our goals are to:


- Care more for the individual athlete than a national reputation

Evaluation Procedures

- 1) Choose your location and register for the All Star Evaluations on our Parent Portal at championcheerallstars.com. Provide payment for the \$70 evaluation fee and your \$250 down payment. (Use promo code CCA20 to save \$35 if paid by 4/15; save \$20 if paid by 4/25; save \$10 if paid by 4/28.) If we do not have a team for your age (6-18 year olds as of 8/31) and ability level, your down payment will be refunded to you within two weeks of evaluations.
- 2) Attend your location's Skills Evaluation on Tuesday, May 3rd. Evaluations at our Southlake location will be from 4:30-9 PM come and go. Evaluations at our Justin location will be from 6-8 PM come and go.
- 3) If you cannot attend the May 3rd Skills Evaluation due to Summit travel, please schedule a makeup evaluation by emailing whitney@championcheerallstars.com for Southlake or jake@championcheerallstars.com for Justin.
- 4) At the Skills Evaluation, athletes will be assigned to a group to workout with over the next few weeks as teams are formed. Group Clinics begin Wednesday, May 4th.
- 5) If you would like to be considered for a flyer position and qualified a Heelstretch and Scorpion at the Skills Evaluation, attend the optional Flyer Tryout on Saturday, 5/7 from 9-10:30 AM. The optional Flyer Tryout is \$10 at the door.
- 6) Rosters will be posted between Friday, 5/13 and Thursday, 5/27. First team practices and parent/athlete meetings will be scheduled at that time.

- Down Payment - \$250
- Uniform*- \$300 plus tax
- Warm Ups*- \$115 plus tax
- Makeup- \$30 plus tax
- Bow*- \$20 plus tax
- Optional Pine Cove Retreat- \$168
- Annual Insurance Fee and Registration Fee- \$20 Per Athlete for Insurance and \$20 Per Family for Registration
- Transportation/Lodging for Out of Town Competitions

*Southlake will carry over these items from the 2015-2016 Season. Returning athletes can keep their current items. There will be a resale event where new athletes might be able to purchase used items at a reduced cost.

Additional Information

- All Champion Cheer and Premier accounts must be paid in full to be eligible for the 2016-2017 Season.
- Accounts may be paid upfront for a \$120 discount.
- Both the upfront payment and the first monthly payments will be due by Mon., May 16th. All remaining monthly payments will be billed on the 1st of each month.
